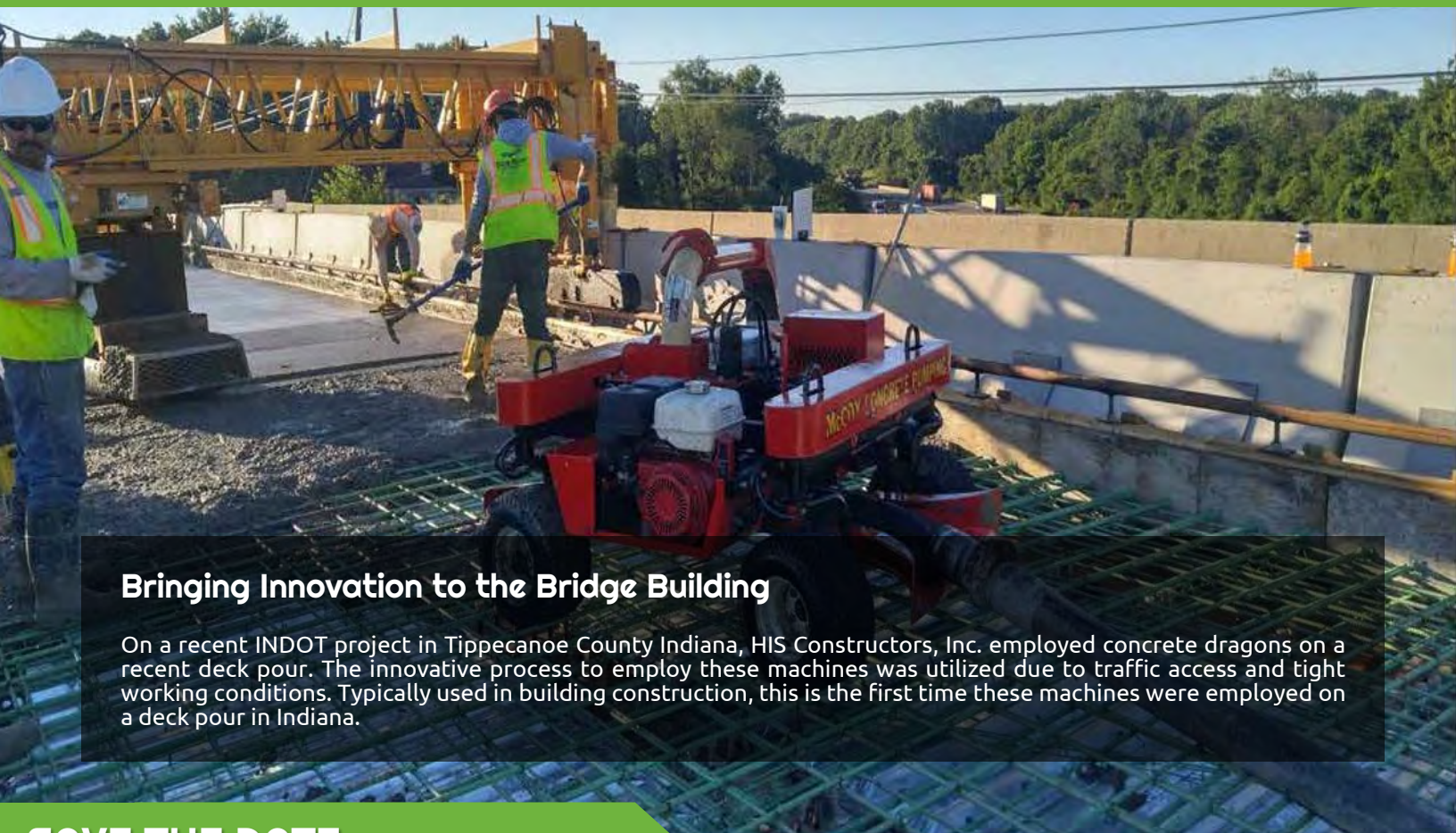




Round-a-bout Construction on former Superfund Site

HIS Constructors, Inc. (HIS) is currently building a round-a-bout and installing storm sewer on a former Superfund Site in Kokomo, IN.
